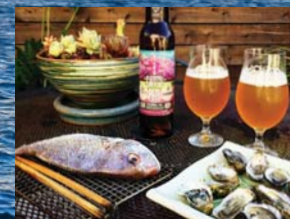

DID YOU KNOW?

• Emeryville is only 1.2 sq mi, yet has 70 public art works & 230 art installations. You can download the Art in Public Places map (an ArtWalk tour) from the City's website @ci.emeryville.ca.us.

• Emeryville is one of only 14 California State-designated Cultural Districts awarded for being innovative in the midst of a renaissance devoted to art and creative production.

• A storied past, referred to as an outlaw town, a renegade town, this district was named Rotten City – Emeryville Cultural Arts District and today is home to entrepreneurial renegades, innovators & artists. Chief Justice of the US, Earl Warren, dubbed Emeryville "the rottenest city on the Pacific Coast" in 1927!
